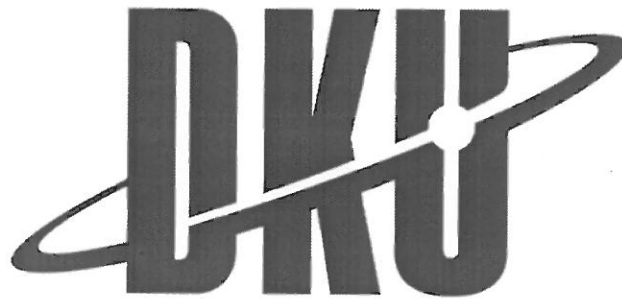

In 1968, Professor Robert Rosenthal from Harvard University and Lenore Jacobson, who had been an elementary school teacher, carried out an experiment. They first gave an IQ test to students and then chose some of them. They gave the list of the students to teachers, saying that those students were most likely to show the biggest improvement. Eight months later, they tested all the students again and found out that those who were in the list had improved a lot on the test. The teachers' expectations of those students had played a major role in this change.

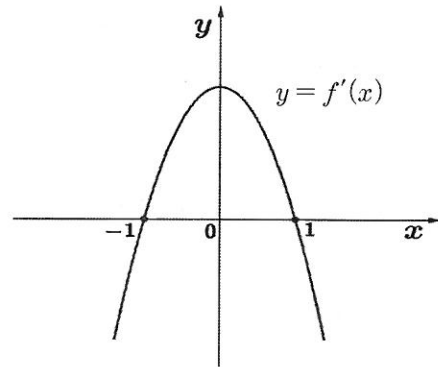
